I. The use of was and were. El uso de was y were.

To express ourselves in the past tense, we can use was or were depending on the pronoun.

Para expresarnos en tiempo pasado, podemos usar was o were, dependiendo del pronombre en la oración.

We put 'was' or 'were' between the subject and the object or complement of the sentence. As the example shows:

Colocamos 'was' o 'were' entre el sujeto y el objeto o complemento de la oración. Así como muestra el ejemplo:

Affirmative	Negative
I <u>was</u> happy He <u>was</u> hungry She <u>was</u> a nurse It <u>was</u> big We <u>were</u> early You <u>were</u> at school They <u>were</u> quiet	I <u>wasn't</u> happy He <u>wasn't</u> hungry She <u>wasn't</u> a nurse It <u>wasn't</u> big We <u>weren't</u> early You <u>weren't</u> at school They <u>weren't</u> quiet

We can use it in a negative form too, using 'wasn't' or 'weren't'.

También podemos usar en su forma negativa, usando 'wasn't' o 'weren't'
