Adverbs of Frequency






Adverbs of Frequency




We use adverbs of frequency to talk about how often an action takes place. We will only use the following adverbs of frequency:



→ Always (100%)	I always eat all my food
→ Usually (80%)	I usually do my homework
→ Often (50%)	I often walk my dog
→ Sometimes (20%)	I sometimes play football
→ Never (0%)	I never eat sweets


Adverbs of Frequency

- We always wake up at 7 AM (100%)
- He usually eats a sandwich at work (80%)
- They often spend Christmas with friends (50%)
- She sometimes eats ice cream (20%)
- I never listen to rock music (0%)





Answers with do or does



Answers with do or does



As you already know, we use do or does to make questions. Today, we will learn that we can also use do and does to answer these questions.

The first thing we need to think about if the answer is yes or no:

Do you like chocolate?

Yes, I do (+) / No, I don't (-)

Does she like lasagna?

Yes, she does (+) / No, she doesn't.(-)

We also need to take into account if the questions is using do or does.





Does he play football?
Yes, he does. (+)



Do I like broccoli?
No, I don't (-)



Does she do her
homework?
Yes, she does (+)



Do they go to
school?
No, they don't (-)





The use of don't



The use of don't



We can use don't as a **command** or a **sentence**.

We use don't as a **command** when we want to give **instructions**.

Don't smoke.

Don't enter.

Don't speak!

And we can use don't as a sentence:

I don't like peppers

You don't play Fortnite.



The use of don't



The main difference is that commands **don't usually** use pronouns at the beginning. Sentences **always** use a pronoun at the beginning.

Don't cry! (command)

You don't believe in magic (sentence)
