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THE DATE



THE DATE



We can think of the date in English as a recipe that has different ingredients, we use the following recipe for our 'date' cake.

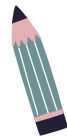
First, we need to know what day of the week it is. The first day in our recipe, is the day of the week.

Monday	Tuesday	Wednesday	Thursday	Friday	Saturday	Sunday
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Then, we continue with the month:

January	February	March	April	May	June
July	August	September	October	November	December

THE DATE



Next to the month, we add the ordinal number of our day. Remember that ordinal numbers are special and they carry two letters next to them. These letter are related to their ending.

1 - first -1st
2 - second - 2nd
3- third -3rd
4- fourth- 4th
5 - fifth - 5th
6- sixth- 6th
7- seventh- 7th
8- eight- 8th
9- ninth- 9th
10- tenth- 10th
11- eleventh- 11th
12- twelfth- 12th
13- thirteenth- 13th

14- fourteenth- 14th
15- fifteenth- 15th
16- sixteenth- 16th
17-seventeenth-17th
18- eighteenth- 18th
19- nineteenth- 19th
20- twentieth- 20th
21- twenty-first- 21st
22- twenty-second- 22nd
23- twenty-third- 23rd
24- twenty-fourth- 24th
25- twenty- fifth- 25th

26- twenty-sixth- 26th
27- twenty-seventh-27th
28- twenty-eighth-28th
29- twenty-ninth- 29th
30- thirtieth- 30th
31- thirty-first - 31st



THE DATE



To finish, we write the number of the year:

2020, 1993, 1999, 2002, 2001, etc.

So our date will look like this:

Monday, May 4th, 2020

Day, Month (ordinal N°), Year.

Tuesday, July 5th, 1994

Saturday, September 27th, 2005

Remember that we always separate the information with a ,

EXAMPLES

So, if we transfer the date from Spanish to english, it will look a bit like this...

Miércoles, 28 de enero, 1965 → Wednesday, January 28th, 1965.

Jueves, 22 de abril, 2006 → Thursday, April 22nd, 2006.

Lunes, 6 de octubre, 1955 → Monday, October 6th, 1955.

Sábado, 1 de junio, 1980 → Saturday, June 1st, 1980.

Domingo, 3 de mayo, 2001 → Sunday, May 3rd, 2001

Martes, 9 de agosto, 2015 → Tuesday, August 9th, 2015

Jueves, 2 de septiembre, 1999 → Thursday, September 2nd, 1999.





THE USE OF WHERE AND WHEN

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THE USE OF WHEN AND WHERE



We use when and were in questions to obtain different information.

We use 'When' to talk about the time when something will be happening.

We use 'Where' to ask about a place where the action will happen.

When is my mother's birthday? It's on October 10th

When is the party? It's in the afternoon (morning, afternoon, evening, night)

When is the anniversary? It's on November 23rd

Where is my book? It's at school.

Where is my mother? She's at the bank

Where is my bike? It's at home



EXAMPLES

When is Christmas?

It's on december 25th.

It's in the living room.

Where is my dog?

It's in my bedroom.

It's in the morning.

When is my birthday?

It's in my house

It's on May 18th

Where is my school?

It's on february 3rd

It's in San Carlos Avenue.

Where is my father?

He's at work.

It's in the afternoon.
